

What about the U.S.?.

Capitalist Country

1914: Population

12 million tied to Central Powers

- *By* 1917 *US* loaned:
 - Allies: \$2.5 billion
 - Central: \$27 million
- Motivation=TRADE

WWI created thousands of American millionaires

Capitalistic Motives Threatened!

- Unrestricted Submarine Warfare
 - Attacking any ship whether military, passenger or merchant

Trading

Blockades

Even **NEUTRAL**

Lusitania (May 1915)

- British passenger liner sunk
- 1,200 passengers parish - 128 Americans!

Sussex Pledge

Resume unrestricted

- Must warn before attack
- Hurts German advantage \rightarrow stalemate ensues \rightarrow what will Germany do?

Resume unresurcieu warfare... WHY? 3 US commercial ships sunk Zimmerman Telegram/

- Effort to prevent US troops from reaching Europe • Encoded message from Germany to Mexico \rightarrow make war with US; get prized land back
- British intercepted...

April 1917 US enters war after a series of events which attacked their existence...

- Massive losses


- Rasputin Power -Czar to War




World War one ends: -- 11th hour -- 11th day -- 11th month... of 1918 November 11, 1918

Wilson's Fourteen Points




THE FOURTEEN POINTS

- "Open covenants of peace . . ."
- 2. "Absolute freedom upon the seas . . . "
- 3. "The removal, . . . of all economic barriers . . . "
- 4. "Adequate guaranties . . . [of disarmament]"
- 5. [Equitable colonial self-determination]

(Woodrow Wilson-Jan. 18, 1918) 6-13. Specific provisions relating to: Russia, Belgium, France (including Alsace-Lorraine), Italy, Austria-Hungary, Balkan Nations, Turkey (and the Dardenelles), "An independent Polish state . . . "

14. "A general association of nations . . ." [The League of Nations]
